Tracey Gray is vice president of communications for Raytheon, a business of RTX that specializes in integrated air and missile defense, advanced sensors, space-based systems, hypersonics, effectors and cyber solutions. He also serves as the vice president of global business communications for RTX. In these roles, he oversees RTX-level business communications strategy, including the development and execution of business-level campaigns across the enterprise.

Gray previously served as vice president of Communications & External Affairs for Raytheon Intelligence & Space, as well as vice president of Communications for Raytheon Space and Airborne Systems prior to Raytheon Company's merger with United Technologies Corporation in 2020. He previously held several leadership positions, including communications for global business development and public affairs.

Prior to joining Raytheon, Gray held intelligence, strategy and policy roles at the Department of Defense and the Department of the Navy. He also served as a member of the advance team for the Office of the Vice President of the United States under the Clinton administration.

Gray is a board member of MATHCOUNTS, an organization that hosts an annual competition for elite math students across the United States. Additionally, he serves on the executive committee for the USO National Capital District Advisory Board. He earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from Bucknell University and a master's degree in public administration from the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs at Syracuse University.
